Laboratory

BCSS has an extensive science lab which provides an experimental foundation for the concepts introduced. Students enhance their learning by doing varied experiments which kindles their interest and develop critical thinking. It also moves away from rote learning and enriches their thinking ability and drawing skills. It enables the learners to familiarize themselves with experimental apparatus, scientific methods applied, and to make careful observations and draw conclusions in relation to the experiment.



Examinations

There will be no formal test or examination for Nursery and K.G. The monthly performance will be reported in a term report and will be presented to parents after each term, in which the day to day work and their achievement in each field will be indicated. Their promotion to the next class will be on the child's performance in all the fields throughout the year.

Minimum pass marks are 40% in aggregate from class 1st to 12th. Students who are not able to pass the same class for two successive years shall be withdrawn from the school.

If a child is absent for any examination, re-examination will be conducted as per the rules and regulations of the school.



Teacher-Parent Home Visits :

In order to strengthen the bonding between school and parents, our school has been innovative in creating the 'Teacher-Parent' home visit. Once a year, teachers visit their students' home to meet parents. Parents are advised to give open feedback to teachers as well as seek advice to ensure that their children show their full potential. Home visits foster a strong relationship between teachers and their students.

Students Counselling

School counselors offer individual counselling to help students resolve personal or interpersonal problems. They may also offer small group counselling to help students enhance listening and social skills, learn to empathize with others and find social support through healthy peer relationships. School guidance counselor work with students in kindergarten through 12th grades to help solve all types of problems.

Recommendations to students

- Every student must develop the habit of being punctual. She/he is expected to be present in the morning assembly. Late arrivals may be sent home.
- We expect every student to be polite, friendly and well behaved in and outside the school.
- Students are supposed to be respectful towards the school authorities.
- Students are expected to work with cheerfulness and face difficulties with courage and firm determination.

Scholarships and Other Rewards

- **Scholarships** : - Every year students belonging to SC, ST, backward and minority groups are awarded according to the guidelines of State Government.
- Position Holders in their respective classes are honoured in the school's Felicitation Ceremony.
- Prizes and rewards for sports and inter-house competitions are also awarded.
- Books being the wisest of counselors and the most patient teachers are awarded from time to time for various in-house competitions.

Admission and Registration

- Admission open for all students irrespective of their caste, creed and community.
- Admission is ordinarily given to children of age 3-3.6 years to play group as on 1st April of the year of admission.
- Students for Nursery are admitted on the basis of interview only but students seeking admission to K.G have to appear in written tests and interviews. Parents are expected to be present at the time of interview for admission.
- The admission test will cover English, Hindi, Mathematics & Science based on the syllabus of the preceding class to which admission is sought.
- In all matters pertaining to admission, the decision of the principal will be final. The principal may reject any application without assigning any reasons thereof.
- Admission to class 11th faculties would be on merit and the principal reserves the right on admission.

Enclosures

The following enclosures should be compulsorily attached with the registration form:

- (a) Birth Certificate (Only for Nursery, Kindergarten, Preparatory).
- (b) Transfer Certificate from the school attended previously.
- (c) copy of academic performance sheet of the previous class.
- (d) A Photocopy of Aadhaar Card.
- (e) Two latest passport size coloured photographs.
- (f) Family photograph (Child with Parent)

Mode of Payment

- All payments should be made/paid as per the instructions in the Fees card.
- All dues are to be paid in advance on the 5th of every month.
- A fine of 10 rupees per day will be charged for the late payment of fee.
- If a child leaves the school in the mid-session for any reason, then six months fee will be charged.
- There will be a fee day on the 5th of every month. If in any case, parents are not able to deposit the fee on time, they will have to submit a reasoning document for late payment.
- The prospectus fee of 200 rupees per child is neither refundable nor transferable.
- No reduction in any fees will be made for continued absence on any ground.

Transportation Facility

The school will provide transportation facilities to students on payment of fixed monthly charges payable for 12 months. Transportation once available shall not be discontinued. For any reason or mechanical breakdown, you have to manage yourself for conveyance.



Parent-Teacher Meeting

The school organizes Parent-Teacher Meetings on every second Saturday of the month to discuss child education and welfare. Parent's attendance is compulsory in such meetings.

Parents are requested to visit school campus for periodic parent-teacher meetings to discuss the performance of their children.

Faculty

All teachers at the BCSS are core professionals and children friendly. We are trying to impart in-service training to make them comfortable and competent in using technology as a tool, just like any other teaching aid.

Discipline

By discipline, we mean to develop three major aspects of our students' personality.

- To make each and every student responsible and self-reliant.
- To transform an individual into a loving and lovable social being.
- To make our students conscious and aware of their role in society.

Attendance

- Regular attendance is an important feature of successful learning. A prior written application for leave must be submitted well in advance. In case of illness and other unforeseen circumstances the guardian should inform the principal in written as soon as possible. 85% attendance is compulsory for the child to be eligible for exams.
- The name of any student who has been absent for 5 days without information shall be struck off. Re-admission fee Rs. 300/- will be charged.
- Every student must be present on the opening day of the school after each vacation.

Classwork and Homework

Every child is required to do the allotted classwork and homework regularly. Merits are given to the children doing their classwork and homework daily. These factors are taken into consideration in selecting the best students of school.

Our Pre-Primary Play School

A home away from home with a hygienic environment for the young ones, BCSS is a wonderful world of fun and learning. We plan and create activities that help growing children in developing learning abilities. At BCSSIC, we provide safe and an enlightening and environment for children to enjoy playing and learning.

Play-centric activities foster the major domains of development such as social, emotional, language, cognitive, sensory, fine and gross motor development. We give children a new stimulating experience through good story books, ample play materials, music, outing and a host of events conducted throughout the year.





Disciplinary Rules

- Students have to come to school on time. Every student should carry with him/her the school homework diary every day.
- Late-comers will not be admitted to the class without the signature of Principal/Headmistress in the school diary.
- Mobile and cameras are strictly prohibited inside the school premises.
- The General Assembly every day in the morning is an integral part of the timetable of our school. On Wednesday & Saturday, all students are supposed to come in their respective House Dresses.
- Once children have entered the school, they can't leave the school premises without the permission of the Principal.
- Verbal assurance: No verbal assurance given by any member of the staff will be accepted as binding on the school. Similarly, no verbal statements made by parents will be accepted.
- Suggestions or complaints if any should be made confidentially in writing to the Principal.
- While communicating with the school, parents should mention in their letters the full name, class and section of their ward. Change in address or telephone number, if any, must be intimated as early as possible.
- Parents or guardians should see that all school assignments and homework given in the school diary are completed. The remarks in the school diary by the teachers or principal must be signed by the students, parents.
- Parents are not allowed to see their children or meet teachers during the school hours without the permission of the principal.
- Strict regularity and Punctuality, Obedience, Courtesy in words and deeds, cleanliness in dress and proper care of books and school property are expected from every student.
- Every child must take part in school games and other activities, unless declared physically unfit by a medical certificate exempted by the principal.



Progress Report

- Parents are requested to collect the monthly progress report of their ward. The report card, after being signed by the parents, must be returned to the school within 3 days, failing which a fine of 200 rupees will be charged.
- Disciplinary action will be taken against any child who is found to have used unfair means in the periodic tests and annual examination and should the child concerned continue the offence, strict action will be taken against the child.
- No appeals by the parents for promotion will be entertained.



Parent School Relationship

- It is the duty of the parents to see that children come punctually to school and are clean and neatly dressed.
- Co-operation between parents and school authorities is paramount's importance for the ultimate achievement of school objectives in aspect of the school curriculum. The attendance of parents at all functions and parent-teacher meetings, is deeply appreciated by the school authorities.
- Remarks in the school diary and progress report should be signed by the parents regularly.
- The parents shall ensure that their child is observing hygiene and sanitation rules and shall always keep themselves clean.

Role of Parents

- Parents are requested to look out into their student's homework diaries everyday and see that the lessons and homework assigned for the next day are done.
- Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities in enforcing regularity and discipline and see that the children prepare their lessons & tests and also take active interest in all school activities.
- Parents are recommended to call on the principal office at least once in each term, to ascertain the conduct and progress of their children.
- Complaints, if any, should be made to the principal in written and not to the class teacher.
- Private tuition is not encouraged. If they are necessary, it is advised to the parents to consult the principal to get written permission.
- In case if the diary is lost, you can buy a new one with a payment of 80 rupees.
- Change of address or phone number must be immediately corrected in this diary and communicated to the school office.
- In case a student fails to return the book to the library within the stipulated time, a fine of 5 rupees per day.
- Use of mobiles/bullying/fighting/use of abusive language/bunking class / misbehaving with teacher are serious acts of indiscipline and likely to incur suspension / withdrawal from school.
- Parents can meet the principal only between the hours mentioned on all working days. They can meet the teachers during the Parents'-Teacher Meetings.
- It is mandatory for students of class XI & XII to have a driving licence for gearless scooters.
